

Joyful shopping at Grand Indonesia Shopping Mall with Instek Digital

The Grand Indonesia Shopping Mall is a seven-hectare complex that houses the recently renovated 5-star Hotel Indonesia, a state-owned landmark opened on August 5, 1962 that has hosted VIPs from all over the world, a 35-story residential block, a 57-story office tower and the biggest shopping mall in Jakarta. The security system boasts over 900 cameras and 90 hybrid DVRs and is managed through MatriVideo Command Center.

The Grand Indonesia Shopping Town used Instek Digital's SDK to integrate with ST Electronics' Unizon IBFMS (Integrated Building Facility Management System) to create a dynamic system that can manage electronic door access control, the PA and fire alarm system, security intrusion alarm monitoring, guard tour tracking and reporting, photo ID badging and card printing, case management reports, video archiving, data importing and exporting, and the more than 900 analog and digital cameras around the complex. The Grand Indonesia Shopping Town's surveillance platform is a glimpse of what is capable using Instek Digital's flexible SDK.
